



- 5. Nursing : Health Related Sciences



Lessons Learned

- Start earlier & Pivot Intentionally!
- Close the loop- update faculty of outcome
- Make multiple calls and call in evenings
- Track data



The District student survey combined with our Survey Monkey results show that we outperformed District averages in making students feel **welcome, guided, and engaged.**


Peer coaches touch (phone call, text, email, or coaching meeting), all first-year students once a semester, high-touch students 2-3 times a semester.
